

PARTNER PLAY (TYPICAL AGE 3)

At the age of three, children are transitioning from "parallel play" (playing near others) to "associative play" (playing with others). Instruction is designed to support this social-emotional leap while building foundational cognitive skills.

Children attend from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, with flexible enrollment options for 2, 3, or 5 days a week.

A Sample Day

- **Welcome & Discovery:** Enjoy table-top activities and/or open play to facilitate a smooth transition into the school morning.
- **Circle Time:** An engaging gathering where we introduce the daily letter or number, along with our calendar and music.
- **Guided Exploration:** Rotate through various learning centers that focus on art, science, and math manipulatives.
- **Snack:** A time to engage in social conversations.
- **Music and Movement:** Bluebird Music Together, Yoga, or a teacher led movement and song activity or game.
- **Closing Circle:** Reflect on God's goodness and the day's learning.
- **Daily Outdoor Recess or Gym Time**
