



POWER PLAY (TYPICAL AGE 5)

The Power Play year provides the advantage of the "gift of time," offering a unique "gap year" for children to develop essential maturity and leadership skills. Our class creates an ideal setting for families who wish to enjoy an extra year before formal kindergarten, or for those seeking social and academic enrichment to their **Homeschool Kindergarten experience. Children attend from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, with options for 3 or 5 days a week.**

A Sample Day

- **Soft Start & Inquiry Play:** Free choice book selections and conversations.
 - **Morning Meeting:** Literature-based circle time brings phonological awareness, language, and social skills together through interactive read-alouds and discussions. A daily focus on the calendar and weather provides educational opportunities for number sense and graphing.
 - **Literacy Workshop:** 45 minutes of differentiated small-group rotations and free choice centers.
 - **Snack:** Time for practicing independence and social interaction.
 - **Math & Science or Music:** Whole group activities focused on number sense and science exploration. Bluebird Music Together Class, yoga or classroom teacher led music and movement.
 - **Closing Circle:** Reflect on God's goodness and the day's learning.
 - **Daily Outdoor Recess or Gym Time**
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
